
The following are some Scripture readings that speak of God's love - aroha and desire to be

One thing I ask of the Lord, that will I seek after; to live in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in his temple.

I believe that I shall see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord. Thomas Merton's father was a New Zealander. Thomas was orphaned at 16, became a communist at 20 and at 23 became a follower of Christ.

He was a reporter for the New York Times and at age 24 he became a Trappist monk in a monastery in Kentucky where he remained until his death in 1969.

This prayer of his could be the words of many people at different times in their lives.

My Lord God,
I have no idea where I am going.
I do not see the road ahead of me.
I cannot know for certain where it will end.

Nor do I really know myself, and the fact that I think that I am following your will does not mean that I am actually doing so. But I believe that the desire to please you does in fact please you. And I hope that I have that desire in all that I am doing. I hope that I will never do anything apart from that desire. And I know that if I do this you will lead me by the right road though I may know nothing about it.

Therefore will I trust you always though I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of death. I will not fear, for you are ever with me, and will never leave me to face my perils alone
