SAINT MARTIN OF TOURS Patron saint of Beggars & Wine makers

Saint Martin was born just after Christianity became legal in the Roman Empire. At the age of 10 he chose to become a Christian and at 15 he entered the military. He is well known for the story about finding a beggar on a cold night and cutting his own cloak in half with his sword to share it with the man. That night he had a vision of Jesus saying that he had shared his cloak with him. At the age of 20 he refused his wages and said he could no longer fight as a soldier as it was against his beliefs as a Catholic. He later established a monastery in Tours which was used by the Benedictines, and eventually became a Bishop.
